It's important to succeed and by concentrating on the areas you are already good at you will have a better chance of becoming even surer of yourself. Remember that success builds upon success.


### 3. Exude confidence even if you don't feel like it.

### 4. Look at yourself in a different way than you are used to doing.



Education provides man power like doctors, mechanics, pilots, teachers etc. They can play an important role for the development of the country. Educated person can solve the problem easily and find out


what is good and what is bad. He does not blindly accept change. They are always involved in creative works. Education teaches us not to be proud. Education is like a candle which makes the dark place bright.

કરીએ, જંક ફૂડ, ફાસ્ટ ફૂડ, બહારનું ભોજન શક્ય તેટલું ટાળીએ. પોષ્ટિક આહાર, ફળોનો ભોજનમાં સમાવેશ કરીએ. પૂરતી ઉંઘ લઈએ. બપોરે ઉઘવાનું ટાળીએ. બપોરે માત્ર ૧૫ મિનિટ નો આરામ લઈએ. આમ આપણે શારીરિક નિરોગી રહીએ. ધનવંતરીનું પૂજન એટલે માત્ર શારીરિક નિરોગી જ નહિં માનસિક રીતે પણ નિરોગી રહેવું. અત્યારે શારીરિક રોગની સાથે સાથે માનસિક રોગીઓની સંખ્યા પણ વધતી જાય છે.

માનસિક નિરોગી બનવા માટે પૂરતી ઉંઘ કરવી. રાત્રે ૧૦ વાગ્યે સૂઈ જવું તથા સવારે ૫ વાગ્યે ઉઠી જવું. છ કલાકથી ઓછી ક્યારેય ઉંઘ ન કરવી જોઈએ.

શક્ય તેટલો મોબાઈલ નો ઉપયોગ ટાળવો જોઈએ. અત્યારે હાલત એવી હોય કે દર બે મિનિટે મોબાઈલમાં જૂએ કે કોનો મેસેજ આવ્યો, મારી દષ્ટિએ તે પણ એક માનસિક બીમારી છે.

માનસિક રીતે મજબૂત બનવા માટે સવારે ઉઠી ૧૦ મિનિટ નું ધ્યાન કરવું જોઈએ. દરરોજ સવારમાં ૧૫ થી ૨૦ મિનિટનું વોકીંગ કરવું જોઈએ.





but it also supports our emotional intelligence and emotional growth.


